The 52nd Annual Flickertail Woodcarvers Show will be held at the Bismarck Public Schools Career Academy, which is located on the east side of Bismarck State College campus. The Bismarck Public Schools Career Academy will provide tables and chairs. Bring your own tablecloth. Selling is not only allowed, it is encouraged – based upon public feedback.

The Flickertail Woodcarvers refund policy is:

- If you withdraw before September 11th, you will receive 100% of your fees refunded.
- If you withdraw after September 11th and before September 30th, you will receive 50% of your fees refunded.
- If you withdraw on September 30th or later, you will not receive any refunds.

Cottonwood Bark Tree House class information: The cost of the Mayer brothers' class is \$100, which includes the cost of the wood supplies for the project. The class will meet at the (meeting site is in the works), on Friday, October 7th from 9 AM to 4 PM to 5:00 PM and at the Bismarck Public Schools Career Academy Saturday and Sunday, October 8th and 9th from 8:00 AM to 11:15 AM. The Mayer brothers' class is designed to encourage students of all levels to expand their level of artistic expression. Bark carving is easy. And fun! Class is open to 14 students. Standard carving knives and gouges will be used.



Eric Gaasland – Dala Horse carving class information: The cost of Eric’s class is \$30. The class will meet at the Bismarck Public Schools Career Academy Saturday and Sunday October 8th and 9th from 8:00 to 11:15 AM. The project will be carving and painting a stylized dala horse. Several patterns and options will be available for students to select from. An example of the project is shown below. Class is open to 10 students.



Eric was born with a carving knife in his hand. Legend has it that by the time he was three, he was nicknamed the ‘Warrior’ after the fierce dragon heads that he carved on any Viking ship that set anchor in Duluth. Eric has a unique style of teaching, a blend of laughter and encouragement that makes everyone want to carve. Teaching has helped him learn to be a better carver, a better human. Becky Weisgerber – Brooms and more brooms: The cost of Becky’s class is \$30. The class will meet at the Bismarck Public Schools Career Academy Saturday and Sunday October 8th and 9th from 8:00 to 11:15 AM.



The first day will center on the basic broom-tying mechanic as we make a whisk broom and pot scrubber. The second day will expand on those skills, adding a handle and a decorative plaited neck to make your choice of a light "cobwebber" or full-size floor broom. There will be several colors of



nylon twine to choose from, and a selection of foraged local wood for handles. All supplies needed will be included in the class. Class is open to 10 students.



Becky is an artist that takes woodcarving to a new level. From specialty buttons, to spoons, brooms, and so much more, her artistic vantage point revels in the beauty that can be found in our daily tools and the joy of making what you need with what you find.
