

Succulents - cacti and more

You will need a square or rectangular piece of wood, with the length long enough to hold.

Place a line for the top of your pot. Divide the top plant into segments, depending on the style you want. A single segment for a barrel cactus, two or three for a blooming cactus, or go crazy with a snake plant.

You can even blend your succulents together with each other.

The pot design is up to you!

Finishing paint: paint the plant a green of your choice. Cactus flowers are usually pink or yellow. The pot is entirely up to your imagination.

You can try painting the pot, and then cutting into it with a V-tool afterwards for some interesting designs.
